## ADELAIDE AIRPORT HAS RECORDED THE FOLLOWING AERONAUTICAL PASSENGER TRAFFIC PERFORMANCE FOR THE HALF YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 2010

Passenger growth for the six months ending December 2010 has been recorded at 7.4%.

Domestic passengers were up 7.3% in the 6 month period to December, with strong demand being serviced by growth in most of the major airlines.

International traffic increased marginally on the prior year at 1.7%. Factors contributing to current performance would include the continuing economic weaknesses in Europe and the USA and the high Australian dollar.

There are also indications that airfares have started to recover from the heavy discounting seen at the height of the GFC " which could act to restrict growth.

Regional passengers grew 15.1% on prior year numbers and outperformed budget by 5.3%. Services to Port Lincoln and the strengthening of the mining sector have aided in bringing passengers to its highest ever levels.
