

Adelaide Airport achieves 2.6% domestic passenger growth for YTD March FY15

Adelaide Airport Limited (AAL) has continued its trend of positive passenger growth with total growth of 2.9% for the year to 31 March 2015.

Domestic performance has been resilient despite a tough operating environment, with domestic passengers growing +2.6% to 4.8 million for the financial YTD. Domestic growth reflects capacity increases from the low cost market, with an additional 242,000 (+4.2%) seats in comparison to the previous corresponding period.

International passenger numbers declined by 2.5% during the quarter ended 31 March 2015, largely attributable to the cancellation of Air Asia X's Kuala Lumpur service on 25 January 2015, with remaining carriers growing 9.1% for the quarter.

Regional passengers decreased by -2.9% on prior year.
