Adelaide Airport records 10.1% growth in International passengers for Q3 FY18

PAX Summary

Adelaide Airport Limited (AAL) continued its solid all round growth performance into the third quarter of the financial year with a 10.1% growth in international traffic and 3.9% growth in domestic travel.

Domestic passenger growth of 3.9% outperformed capacity growth of 2.9% due to strong overall Seat Load Factors. In March Adelaide welcomed a new carrier on a new route as FlyPelican launched their inaugural flight between Adelaide and Newcastle. FlyPelican are operating three flights per week on Monday, Tuesday and Friday to service tourism and business markets. Within Domestic, Regional resource routes saw 5.6% growth in passengers.

International growth was driven by a 13.3% increase in capacity in the form of Qatar's return to Daily services (up from 5 per week), Seasonal schedule increases to Bali on Jetstar (up to double daily in January before returning to daily) and seasonal schedule increases on China Southern (up to 5 per week from 3 per week in January and February).
