Rex announces Adelaide-Melbourne route

Adelaide Airport has welcomed today's announcement by Rex that it will introduce a new service for customers travelling between Adelaide and Melbourne from 31 March 2021, offering seats in both Business Class and Economy.

This will be just the second service between capital cities offered by Rex, with its Sydney-Melbourne service starting today.

Twice daily flights will depart Adelaide at 6.00am and 1.30pm. Melbourne-Adelaide flights will depart 11.45am and 8.00pm.

Bookings are now available at a promotional fare of \$69 for Economy Class and \$299 for Business Class on the REX website www.rex.com.au. Fares include free 23kg check-in, 7kg carry-on baggage and refreshments on board.

A Boeing 737-800 aircraft, comprising 8 Business Class and 168 Economy Class, seats will be deployed for the flight, offering inflight catering, integrated inflight entertainment and Wi-Fi capability.

Adelaide Airport Managing Director, Mark Young, said: "We are excited that REX has chosen Adelaide-Melbourne as just its second route between capital cities.

"This service provides South Australian passengers with more choice when flying on our most popular route, and will be introduced just in time for the Easter and school holiday peak period.

"I congratulate REX on recognising the future growth opportunities on this route as we continue the COVID recovery. Rex has been a great supporter of the Adelaide market for many years - currently flying to several regional destinations across South Australia."

REX also operates a fleet of 60 Saab340 aircraft (pre-COVID) on 1,500 weekly flights to 59 destinations throughout all states in Australia.
